

## **Barn Rules**

- 1. Children (anyone under the age of 18) must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- <u>DRESS CODE</u>: All riders must wear ASTM-approved safety helmets at all times. Long pants (britches or jodhpurs are proffered), an appropriate shirt (no halter tops or t shirts with messages or images) and paddock boots are required dress. Please come dressed prior to arrival.
- 3. All riders must sign a **liability waiver** and all other required HTS paper work before they will be allowed to mount.
- 4. Never pet or feed a horse you do not know. **Ask permission**.
- 5. Horses and ponies are to be secure at all times. **DO NOT** leave your mount unattended.
- 6. Never touch anyone else's tack, equipment or property without permission.
- 7. **Clean up** after yourself and your horse. This includes common areas, such as wash stalls.
- 8. **No horseplay** at the barn. This includes running, shouting, throwing projectiles, waving objects, wrestling, fighting and chasing.
- 9. **No gossip** at the barn. If you have a conflict, resolve it with the other person or speak with HTS management.
- 10. **NO** Dogs are allowed on the premises.
- 11. Smoking is **PROHIBITED!**
- 12. **Music** is controlled by HTS staff.
- 13. **No riding** in the barn, pastures or parking lot.
- 14. Keep barn aisle ways clear at all times. Groom, tack up, medicate and pet horses in designated areas. Use the wash stall to apply hoof dressings of medications to the hoof area.
- 15. Inhumane, neglectful or malicious treatment of animals or humans will not be tolerated.
- 16. **Respect** other people and their horses when riding or visiting the barn.
